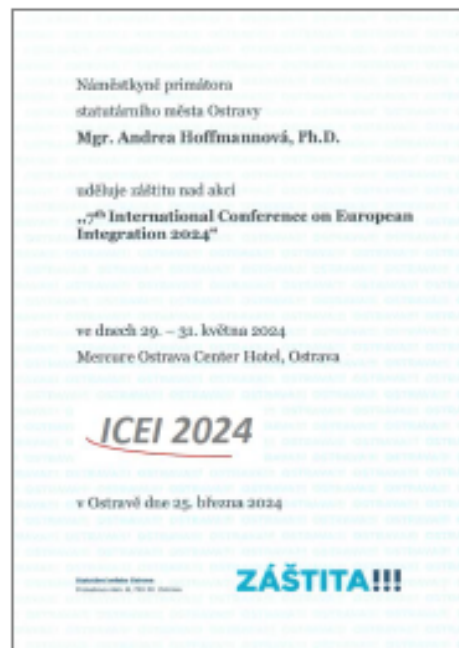

Academic Writing Workshop – Conference outputs are papers and proceedings, but how can we achieve this optimally in today's conditions and offerings? This will be the subject of a workshop.

Workshop focus:

If Writing is a Skill, How Can I Become a 'Pro'? Review Process Strategies: What Do Editors Appreciate? AI in Writing for Publication: Attitudes, Tools, and Other Tips.

The workshop series will create space for the participants to learn, reflect, and grow as writers for publication. We will discuss several strategies in writing for publication, from writing for different audiences (different languages belong to different writing cultures), creating a writing habit, and a publication strategy to communicate with the journal gatekeepers, i.e., editors and reviewers. Participants (both early-career and experienced researchers) will also learn about several valuable tools available to academic authors. The intended learning outcomes for the workshops are: (1) to view professional writing as a process that includes adequate time management, goal setting, and regular writing time; (2) to understand the nature and goals of professional publishing, including critical aspects of new contributions, engaging in the field, and contributing to the discipline; (3) to appreciate the value of peer review, feedback, and revision; (4) to approach the research journal article as a (structured) genre; and (5) to learn about some (AI) tools available.

Safeguarding Research Integrity with Trusted Tools and Data

Web of Science/Clarivate Analytics Workshop – explores how WoS/CA addresses the rising challenges to research integrity, including questionable publishing practices and threats. It focuses on editorial journal selection, quality control, indexing systems, etc.

Workshop focus:

How does Clarivate ensure journal quality, and what are the common reasons for rejection? What measures does Clarivate use to detect and prevent unethical practices in indexed journals?

Today, we are witnessing a rise in the number of journals published and questionable publishing practices. In addition, various threats to research integrity have been growing, including paper mills, image manipulation and the potential for AI abuse. Upholding research integrity is a joint effort performed by research institutions, researchers, funders, publishers, and database providers. Each must take steps to ensure the validity, accuracy, and overall authenticity of scholarly output. In this session, you will discover how Clarivate has taken significant steps to foster research integrity in the Web of Science as part of our ongoing efforts to proactively contribute to maintaining public trust in scientific and scholarly research.
